Deskripsi Singkat MK	This course provides a foundational understanding of the sounds of human language, exploring the mechanisms of speech production and the systems used to transcribe and analyze speech. Students will focus on the intricacies of articulatory phonetics, examine how speech sounds are produced, and learn to use the International Phonetic Alphabet to transcribe and analyze speech data. They will also explore acoustic phonetics, investigating the physical properties of speech sounds. The course adopts a hands-on approach, emphasizing practical application through interactive activities, transcription exercises, and analysis of real-world speech examples. Assessment will be based on a combination of transcription exercises where students have to accurately transcribe and analyze speech samples using the IPA; practical assessments where students have to demonstrate their understanding of articulatory phonetics through sound production exercises; and written exams where students' knowledge of key phonetic concepts and terminology will be assessed. By the end of the course, students will have a solid foundation in phonetic theory and practical skills essential for various linguistic disciplines.

1. **Capaian Pembelajaran Lulusan Program Studi (CPL-Prodi)** adalah rumusan kemampuan yang harus dimiliki oleh lulusan program studi yang mencakup sikap, penguasaan pengetahuan, keterampilan umum, dan keterampilan khusus sesuai dengan jenjang kualifikasi, yang diperoleh melalui proses pembelajaran.
2. **CPL-Prodi yang dibebankan pada Mata Kuliah** adalah bagian dari CPL-Prodi yang dipilih dan relevan untuk dikembangkan melalui suatu mata kuliah, sebagai dasar perumusan capaian pembelajaran mata kuliah.
3. **Capaian Pembelajaran Mata Kuliah (CPMK)** adalah kemampuan yang dirumuskan secara spesifik dan diturunkan dari CPL-Prodi yang dibebankan pada mata kuliah, serta menggambarkan kompetensi yang harus dicapai mahasiswa setelah menyelesaikan mata kuliah.
4. **Sub-CPMK** adalah kemampuan akhir yang direncanakan pada setiap tahap pembelajaran, sebagai penjabaran lebih rinci dari CPMK, bersifat terukur dan dapat diamati sesuai dengan materi pembelajaran.

11. **Bobot Penilaian** adalah persentase kontribusi setiap komponen penilaian terhadap nilai akhir mata kuliah, yang ditetapkan secara proporsional sesuai tingkat kompleksitas dan ketercapaian Sub-CPMK, dengan total keseluruhan sebesar 100%.
