The teaching approach combines lectures, group discussions, and case studies to help students apply these theories to diverse literary works. Assessment procedures include analytical essays, project-based assignments, case studies, reflective reports, and writing assessments, enabling students to critically engage with literature and develop sophisticated interpretations. By the end of the course, students will be equipped with a robust framework for literary analysis, a deeper understanding of the multifaceted nature of literary criticism, and an awareness of how literature intersects with global issues addressed by the SDGs
